Rehearsal begins on January 13th, 2025. Actors must be ensemble-minded and skilled with heightened language. Actors and the Tour Manager are responsible for the load-in and load-out of the tour's venues. Ideal candidates will have experience with stage combat, theatre education, and Shakespeare. STNJ seeks to create an ensemble that is representative of the communities and students we serve. Actors of all ethnicities are highly encouraged to audition.

Artistic Fellows receive a \$400/week stipend, plus fully subsidized housing in Madison, NJ. Masterclasses and company member benefits are also provided.

In-person auditions in New York City will take place October 14, 2024, to be scheduled after a review of submitted headshots, resumes and self-tapes. Callbacks will take place the third week of October 2024.
